



The Urgency

Nearly 90,000 new cases diagnosed each year in the U.S.

Nearly 1 million Americans and 10 million worldwide living with the disease

Second most common neurodegenerative disease after Alzheimer's

Prevalence is expected to rise to 1.2 million by the year 2030 due to the aging of the population

Average age of onset is mid-60's

Economic burden to individuals, families and the U.S. government is nearly **\$52 billion each year**

There is no cure for PD but treatments and expert care can improve quality of life

678 scientists received Parkinson's Foundation funding since 2010.






For Tomorrow: Investing in Breakthroughs

PD GENEration: Mapping the Future of Parkinson's Disease is the first-of-its-kind national initiative that offers genetic testing and genetic counseling at no cost to participants.

Administered through in-person sites or an at-home test, this genetic information will propel us toward **optimizing Parkinson's treatments** and advancing clinical trials.








For Tomorrow: Investing in New Treatments

Through our partnership with Parkinson's UK, we are providing targeted funding to develop new therapies and medications, while increasing resources for research and development.








For Today: Empowering Resources

Access online courses that provide vital training for professionals working with and caring for those with Parkinson's. Many of the courses provide CEU credits.


